THE FACE BEHIND THE FACE

Giuseppe UTANO, ceramic artist in Bolsena

Masks show what moves and drives people. They make visible the inner, which shapes the personality, and projects identity on the face and the whole body figure. On the face is reflected where we arrived (as in H.Hesse's Demian) Giuseppe UTANO will lead the hand-on work on masks, and will teach techniques for modelling clay sculptures. During the week long seminar, evary one will have the opportunitity to create his/her own mask, proceeding from personal biography and mood of the time. With "Max" CZERWENKA participants will learn to use improvisation theatre, digging into the joy of the game, and learning to make mistakes and to even appreciate it, accepting challenges and remain loose. Playfully theatrical work approach to learn methods of improvisation to then apply them to the challenges of life. To begin with improvisation, no special requirements to me met, and the reward is a lot of fun, development of experience and new perspectives on life.

THE STORIES OUR BODIES CAN TELL INTEGRATING BODY AND ART

This workshop will introduce the basic ideas of Body Psychotherapy. Participants will have the opportunity to explore the ways in which somatic experiences, the sensations of the body, can inform personal development. It will be proposed and investigated through personal and group exercises that the core of selfhood and the keys of understanding and transforming our life stories, are to be found firstly in sensations and only secondly in cognition and rational thought.

The resulting moods, irritations, problems, resources and life goals coming up as inner pictures during the body work will be expressed through creative methods of art therapy.

Participants will have the opportunity to explore the traces left by psychodynamic expression tracks and find surprising information in their pictures drawn spontaneously.

SEMINAR 3 27 July – 2 August 2014

HOW TO USE PHOTOTHERAPY TECHNIQUES IN PSYCHOTHERAPY, ARTHERAPY & THERAPEUTIC WORK

Led by: Laura JIMENEZ-ALONSO and Ulla HALKOLA The goal of the workshop is to illustrate, demonstrate and explain ways to use phototherapy techniques in art therapy. The phototherapy techniques include using autobiographical photos like family album photos, symbolic and associative photographs. Participants will learn by doing how to use phototherapy techniques and how to combine them with art therapy techniques. This edition of the seminar will be focused on Self Portraits. The aim is to produce a "Self Portrait Book" which will be done with different kinds of photography techniques like dialogical photographing, by self-timer etc in combination of therapeutic art Participants will bring with them about 12 -20 photographs which have a personal meaning for them. The photos might be from own photo collections like snapshot boxes, files etc. The photo collection has to include at least one photo - in printed form- where the participant is a child, one photo as a teenager and one photo as an adult. Participants are required to bring their own camera, preferably digital, as we will print photos during the workshop.



The role of art therapy will be to provide the possibility for expressing inner pictures of personal conflicts and/or positive resouces through painting or drawing. The art work enables symbolization, and allows important situations to re-emerge and be acted out in a weakened form, that can be afterwards completed in verbal communication. Family photos and photo collections will be combined with inner imagery in order to rewriting and finding our authentic life-story.
